Sehome High School Culminating Project

Key Points to Remember

1. Complete the proposal and all documents electronically and save to your file both here at school and at home, if at all possible.
2. Your faculty contact is Mr. Best who will support your work, along with others, throughout the final step of your culminating project your senior year.
3. Always respond to the proposal prompt with complete sentences, including lots of details because your teacher/readers are ignorant of what is in your brain unless you write your complete thoughts to them.
4. In order for your proposal to be approved, you must complete every single part of it, attach your typed-in and signed Parent/Guardian Consent for Community Advisor, and your typed-in and signed Statement of Integrity.

Protocol to Follow : Project Process

- Make absolutely sure that you have first consulted with your World History teacher if you have a question regarding your proposal. If you do not have World History, then talk with Mr. Best, Culminating Project Coordinator.
- In your discussion with your World History teacher, if a question arises that s/he cannot answer, then be sure to speak with or e-mail Mr. Best.
- If Mr. Best is unable to provide an answer, he will give you the information as to whom at Sehome to contact in order for you to receive what you need.
- These people are informed individuals regarding the culminating project and will also be good sources of information.
